
#### **Extended Leave**

### **Positive Behaviour for Learning**

At Wairoa School we follow a Positive Behaviour for Learners framework and have three 'be' rules in our school: During term 3 the focus on **Be A Learner** will be emphasised across classrooms, playgrounds and the community.
